Triples (2 bowls) 18 ends. Fours (2 bowls) 16 ends.

Teams may play two trial ends before their first game. Trial ends must be finished before the official start time. Teams with byes are able to have practice ends on a rink that they are not playing their other games on if possible.

Played under the Laws of Bowls

Championships

Entries must be in to the Match Committee by 9.00pm on the Wednesday before the event. All team members must be form the same Club. Start time 8.30am. Teams may play two trial ends before their first game. Trial ends must be finished before the official start time. Teams with byes are able to have practice ends on a rink that they are not playing their other qualifying game on. No drawn games. Played under the Laws of Bowls except that 10 minutes only will be allowed for lateness by a player(s) before a game is forfeited. The at fault team will not get extra time. The not at fault team may get the extra time if required.

Men's Singles, Pairs and Triples

Singles (4 bowls), 4 games of 15 ends or 1¼ Hours. 3 and 4 winners qualify for Post Section. Post Section is 15 ends or 1¼ hours. Final 15 completed ends, no time limit

Pairs (3 bowls), 4 games of 11 ends or 1½ hours. 3 and 4 winners quality for Post Section. Post Section 11 ends or 1½ hours. Final 13 completed ends, no time limit. Triples (2 bowls), 4 games of 11 ends or 1½ hours. 3 and 4 winners qualify for Post Section. Post Section 11 ends or 1½ hours. Final 13 completed ends, no time limit.

Fours - Teams may be made up of all men, all women or mixed

Fours (2 bowls), 4 games of 9 ends or 1½ hours. 3 and 4 winners qualify for Post Section. Post Section 9 ends or 1½ hours. Final 13 completed ends, no time limit. In the event of any team(s) not being able to quality after playing the third game and the opposing team has already or cannot qualify, mutual agreement on not playing the fourth game will be accepted.

ELLESMERE BOWLS SUB-CENTRE WOMEN'S EVENTS CONDITIONS OF PLAY – 2020-2021

Women's Championships - Start time 8.30am

Singles - Open to all Ellesmere players.

Junior Singles – For players 5yrs and under.

Two trial ends may be played before the first game. They must be finished before the official start tune, Teams with byes may have practice ends on a rink that they are not playing on in later qualifying games.

Four games of 13 ends or 1 hour. No drawn games. 3 and 4 winners qualify for Post Section. Post Section games 13 ends or 1 hour. Final 13 ends, no time limit.

The Controlling body may change conditions on the day if necessary. Morning tea after the second game. Lunch after the third game.

Pairs (3 bowls). Team members to be from the same club.

Two trial ends may be played before the first game. They must be finished before the official start time. Teams with byes may have practice ends on a rink that they will not play on in later qualifying games.

Four games of 11 ends or 1¼ hours. 3 and 4 winners qualify for Post Section. Post Section 11 ends or 1¼ hours. Final 13 completed ends, no time limit. Lunch after third game.

Played under the Laws of Bowls except that 10 minutes only will be allowed for lateness of a player(s) from the official start time. The at fault team will not get extra time. The not at fault team may get extra time if required.

ELLESMERE BOWLS SUB-CENTRE CONDITIONS OF PLAY – MIXED PAIRS AND FIVES 2020-2021

Mixed Pairs (3 bowls), 4 games of 11 ends or 1¼ hours. Start time 10.00am.

Lunch after the second game, afternoon tea after the last game. To be run as a tournament. Result to be decided by games won. In the event of a tie then ends, then differential. Incorrectly delivered Jack to be delivered by the opposing team. If delivered incorrectly again to be placed on the 2 metre mark. If the end is killed it is to be replayed. Teams may have two trial ends before their first game. They must be finished before the official start time.

<u>Fives</u> - Start time 1.00pm. Two games if 1½ hours. Teams may be mixed, all men or all women. One Pairs (3 bowls) and one Triples (3 bowls) Teams play a different team in the second game. Incorrectly delivered Jack may be placed by the opposing skip. Killed end the Jack will be placed on the 2 metre mark

Dress – Club shirts or whites. Scoring – 2 points for each game won, 1 point for a draw. If a team defaults the opposing team is awarded 4 points. Teams may have two trial ends before their first game, They must be finished before the official start time. A decision on cancellation will be made by 10.30am on the day. Games will be cancelled not rescheduled. If games get through more than 1 hour before being called off then the games played will be considered completed. Results to be sent to the Recorder by the host club on the night of the game if possible. Cards need to be sent to the Recorder in case of a dispute.

ELLESMERE BOWLS SUB-CENTRE ROOSTER COMPETITION – CONDITIONS OF PLAY 2020-2021

Start 1.30pm. Afternoon Tea on the run - \$2 per player.

Teams to comprise of 6 players.

Singles 21 shots. Pairs 21 ends (3 bowls). Triples 21 ends (2 bowls).

Clubs must name 6 players in each team and these must be forwardedto the Ellesmere Match Committee before the first game.

If a player is named in a team then they **cannot** play for any other team. If a player is not named in a team then they may play for any team but once they have played 3 games for any one team they must stay with that team.

Competition Format – Play will be under the control of the Ellesmere Match Committee . Teams will play each other on a round robin basis. If a round is put off it may be rescheduled. If a round is partially completed then those matches will need to be completed prior to the next round, games will restart where they finished prior to interruption. If unable to do so the Match Committee will decide when it will be played. Sixteen completed ends constitutes a game if stopped by inclement weather and will not need to be replayed. In the event of a team defaulting, the Match Committee and opposition to be advised as early as possible, the non-defaulting team will be awarded 6 points. A club with more than one Rooster team cannot gain points from a default from within that club. If for any reason a match cannot be played on the set day the Match Committee are to be notified and that match is to be completed before the next round. Two points for each game won or 1 point each for a draw. The winner shall be the team that wins the round robin. In the event of a tie there will be a play-off. In the event of a play-off the Match Committee will decide on a time and a neutral green. No drawn games in a play-off. All disputes to go to the Match Committee in writing within 48 hours. Teams may have two trial ends before their first game. They must be finished before the official start time.

Results to be sent to the Ellesmere results recorder by the host club on the night of the game if possible. Cards need to be sent to the Recorder in case of a dispute.

ELLESMERE BOWLS SUB-CENTRE BERT CHATTERTON MEMORIAL CUP COMPETITION CONDITIONS OF PLAY – 2020-2021 SEASON

Teams to comprise of five players – all male, all female or mixed. Players to belong to same Club, with the proviso that the opposing club may lend a player or players (maximum 2). Start at 1.30pm – two games – singles and fours. Afternoon tea (\$2 per player) followed by triples & pairs. Singles – 21 shots or 1½ hrs, all other games 1½ hrs.

Drawn games to count. Max points per round are 8-2 per win and 1 per draw. Teams with a bye will be awarded the average of winning points per round, closest to the whole point rounded up, ie total winning points $39 \div 6 = 6.5$ therefore 7 points for that round and rounded down if the points are 6.4, therefore 6 points. In the event of a team defaulting, the Match Convenor must be notified as early as possible and non-defaulting team will be awarded maximum points (8). Match Committee to decide on cancellation of round for whatever reason by 10.30am on day of play. If a round is cancelled it will not be replayed. If rained off before completion of the first game, then that round needs to be completed prior to LAST round. If rained off during second game, then game is considered completed if 1 hour has been played, otherwise game will be considered a draw. Two trial ends may be played before the first game, they must be finished before the official start time. Jacks delivered incorrectly must be re-delivered by opposing team. Killed ends to be replayed, even if done so after the bell. If two or more teams are on equal points after all rounds have been played there will be a play off. This will be arranged by the Match Committee at a neutral green. In the event of teams being equal after the play off then differential will be used and if still equal then the pairs and triples will play an extra end or ends until a winner is obtained.
